Now you know what the big day's all about, get out there, have fun and raise lots of lovely dosh.



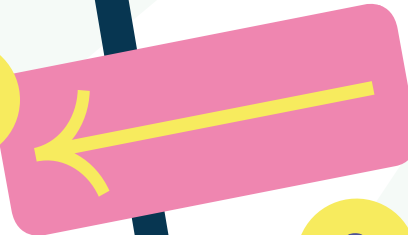


THIS WAY TO THE PARTY

BAKE A DIFFERENCE

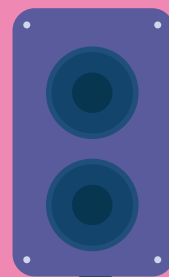
Get baking (or buying – we won't tell) and set up a cake stall to bring in some dough.

MEET LAWAND PIKPA, LESVOS



Three-year-old Lawand was born in Syria. When war broke out, his family fled, making the long, dangerous overland journey to Turkey. From there, a smuggler's boat took them to the island of Lesbos where they face an uncertain future.

Now, with the help of Comic Relief cash, Help Refugees UK is turning a former summer camp into a safe haven for refugee families. As well as fixing practical things like showers and kitchens, they're building a playground for little ones. They're also helping the children learn English and Greek, so they can join local schools and kindergartens.
