

LAWAND'S WORD CARDS

Use this activity to help develop children's reading, listening and art skills. Each of the cards on the following pages is linked to one of the words on the poster 'Lawand's Story'.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- The poster 'Lawand's Story'.
- Printouts of the word cards on the following pages (one for each child).
- Pens, pencils and crayons.

WHAT TO DO

1. Give each child a card and make sure they understand the word on their card. Some children will have the same card, which is fine.
2. Look at the poster as a group and read the children the information, pointing to the key words and pictures. Ask the children to hold their card in the air when they hear 'their' word.
3. Help the children to complete the art activity on their card.




WORD CARDS
