## MAKATON Match

Use this fun and exciting activity to enable children to experience a rich language environment and develop communication skills.

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- The poster 'Lawand's Story'.
- Printouts of the word cards on the following pages (one copy of each).
- Printouts of the Makaton signs on the following pages (one copy of each, A4 size).

#### Communication and language

#### WHAT TO DO

- 1. As a starting point, talk to the children about Makaton and how people use it to communicate. You could watch a clip of the CBeebies show Something Special that features Makaton, or the first-ever CBeebies bedtime story signed in Makaton (by Rob Delaney in November 2018).
- 2. Show the children the poster 'Lawand's Story' and talk about the different words and signs on the poster.
- 3. With the children standing in front of you, hold up each word card in turn and encourage them to say the word with you.
- 4. Put down the cards and do the Makaton sign for each word in turn, encouraging the children to join in with saying and signing the word.
- 5. Display the printouts of the Makaton signs around the room so the children can see them easily, spacing them out as much as possible. Say a word and ask the children to run to the correct Makaton sign. Then try holding up the word cards. Can the children still connect the word to the sign?
