The legal bit: 1. This means that people are only eligible to enter if they either work in the same premises as the promoter, or live in the same premises as the promoter. 5. You may only display this poster or advertise the sweepstake on the relevant premises (see before). 6. The rights of any entrant are not transferable to any other person (and any attempt to transfer them will be treated as ineffective). 7. Each entrant agrees that, if they win, the promoter will donate half the money collected to Red Nose Day on behalf of the winner. 8. The promoter is responsible for ensuring the sweepstake is run properly – Red Nose Day is not a promoter and does not accept any responsibility for your sweepstake.
