





### **VEARS**

On average, a refugee will be unable to return home for nearly 20 years





REFUGEES are people who have been forced to flee their country and cannot return because they are afraid of war, persecution or violence. ITERNALLY DISPLACED PEOPLE have been forced to leave their home but are still in their own country. They may seek safety in another town, in a camp, or even in forests or fields.




