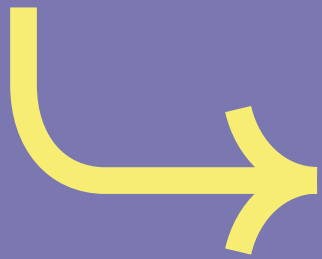

There are more people on the move now than at any other time since the end of World War II. One in every 110 people in the world has been forced to leave home and seek safety in a different part of their own country or in another country.

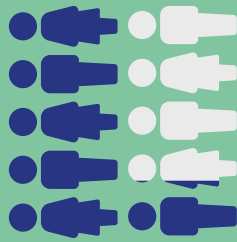

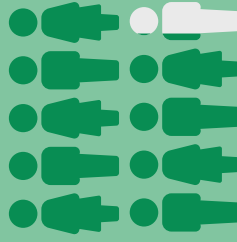

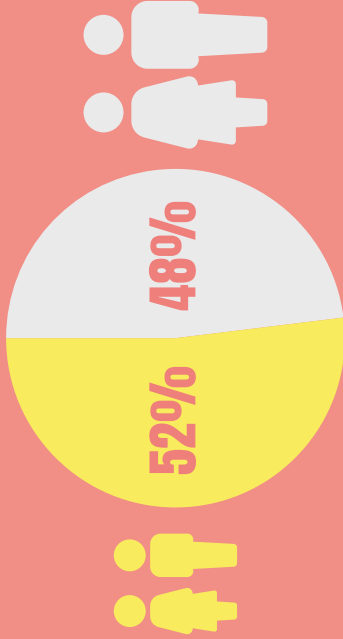

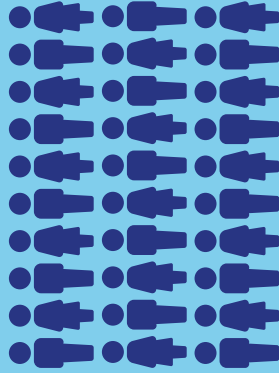

**REFUGEES** are people who have been forced to flee their country and cannot return because they are afraid of war, persecution or violence.

**INTERNALLY DISPLACED PEOPLE** have been forced to leave their home but are still in their own country. They may seek safety in another town, in a camp, or even in forests or fields.
